Morpeth-based 'self-help' school project enters final phases in Tanzania

The major structure of the school building is almost complete.

 \checkmark

Contracts for work on the solarpanelled school roof are under negotiation and the work is expected to commence in January 2016. The Americanbased charity Solar Circle has contributed \$100,000 to this work.

 \checkmark

Roofworks are designed to link with a rainwater recycling and purification system. The construction team are working from room to room, giving the rough brick walls their base coat of plaster.

Specialist contractors have begun the work of installing electrical circuits.





Classrooms are designed to accommodate classes of up to 35 pupils in comfort. Window openings provide for good natural light, controlled by blinds. In addition to the roof installation scheduled to begin during January 2016, other remaining internal works include:

- Installation of framed windows and window blinds
- Wall plastering
- Furniture and fittings

On completion, the school will have facilities for up to 490 pupils.
